

SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

Affirmative	I have black hair.
	My sister has curly hair.
Negative	My grandmother doesn't have white hair. It's brown.
	My sisters don't have green eyes. They're brown.
Yes / No questions	Do you have blue eyes?
	Does your mother have dark hair?

We use the simple present to talk about:

- repeated actions or habits: I **have** breakfast at 7:00 every morning.
- general truths: The sun **orbits** around the earth.

Spelling rules for third person singular

Regular verbs + -s	Verbs ending in vowel + -y = -s	Verbs with -y after a consonant = -ies	Verbs ending in -ss, -x, -ch, -sh = -es	Irregular verbs
talk = talks play = plays	pay = pays say = says	carry = carries study = studies	kiss = kisses fix = fixes watch = watches crash = crashes	have = has go = goes do = does
