

## MAKING REQUESTS

Want		
<b>Affirmative</b>	subject + <i>want</i> (s) + complement	I <b>want</b> a new pair of shoes.
		She <b>wants</b> a new pair of shoes.
<b>Interrogative</b>	<i>Do / Does</i> + subject + <i>want</i> + complement	<b>Do</b> you <b>want</b> to go to the park?
		<b>Does</b> he <b>want</b> to go to the park?

Would like		
<b>Affirmative</b>	subject + <i>would like</i> + complement	We <b>would like</b> to order a sandwich.
		He <b>would like</b> to order a sandwich.
<b>Interrogative</b>	<i>Would</i> + subject + <i>like</i> + complement	<b>Would</b> you <b>like</b> some sugar with your coffee?
		<b>Would</b> she <b>like</b> some sugar with her coffee?

- Generally, use *want* to talk in an informal context and *would like* to talk in a formal context.
