

TAG QUESTIONS (AFFIRMATIVE AND NEGATIVE STATEMENTS)

| | To be statements | Tag question |
|--------------------|--|-------------------------|
| Affirmative | I am a good chef, | aren't I? |
| | He / She / It is a nice friend, | isn't he / she / it? |
| | We / You / They are in Mexico, | aren't we / you / they? |
| Negative | I am not a doctor, | am I? |
| | He / She / It is not very intelligent, | is he / she / it? |
| | We / You / They are not at home, | are we / you / they? |

| | Other verbs statements | Tag question |
|--------------------|-------------------------------------|------------------------|
| Affirmative | I look elegant, | don't I? |
| | He / She / It eats a lot of ham, | doesn't he / she / it? |
| | We / You / They love museums, | don't we / you / they? |
| Negative | I don't study here, | do I? |
| | He / She / It doesn't drink coffee, | does he / she / it? |
| | We / You / They don't cook well, | do we / you / they? |

- Use tag questions with a raising intonation to reassure information you already know.
- Use tag questions with a falling intonation to confirm information you are not sure about.
