Most people outside of Mexico think Mexicans speak Spanish, and that is true. However, many people in Mexico speak other languages. The speakers of those languages are indigenous people, or Native Americans.

What language do Mexicans speak? There are many indigenous groups in Mexico, and many of those groups have distinct languages. In fact, there are more than 100 indigenous languages in Mexico. Only four indigenous languages are spoken by more than 5% of the indigenous population. The table below shows the most widely spoken Native American languages. It also shows the percentage of indigenous people who speak those languages.
